#### G.3. Required Technical Submittal w/Application for Permit Extension

• Description of the Response Action

Following the issuance of the permit, additional test borings will be placed in the escarpment area to delineate the horizontal extent of contamination. Concurrently, sediment samples along the edge of Bailey's Pond and proximate to a weir will be collected and analyzed for priority pollutant metals. The above data will be used as part of a Phase II Comprehensive Site Assessment consistent with the requirements of 310 CMR 40.0835. It is anticipated that part of the Phase II Report will involve a Method 3 Risk Characterization and a Stage II Environmental Risk Characterization due to numerous environmental (aquatic) receptors associated with Bailey's Pond. Moreover, the Method 3 Risk Characterization for human health will be particularly significant in light of the Town's proposed usage of areas near the Bailey's Pond parcel for proposed recreational activities.

Concurrent with the completion of the Phase II, a systematic evaluation of remedial response alternatives is required. Specific remedial options or combinations should be evaluated to determine what options or combination of remedial options is (are) likely to achieve optimum results. The process of systematic evaluation of remedial response alternatives is required to be documented within a Phase III Report.

Based upon the results of the Phase III Report, it is likely that an Activity and Use Limitation (AUL) will be used as a method of risk reduction. This will involve placement of affected soil upon a suitable geotextile liner beneath an asphalt cap. It is unclear at this juncture what level of involvement of construction activities for this cap may be required with the Amesbury Conservation Commission.

During excavation and placement of the affected soil within the area designated for capping, monitoring of the process must be reported to MDEP at required intervals. The actual construction costs of this cap are unknown and will not be determined until the assessment activities described above are completed.

Lastly, a Class A-3 Response Action Outcome (RAO) Statement will be required to be filed with MDEP to close this matter. That RAO must adequately demonstrate that a condition of no significant risk has been achieved with regard to human health, public safety, public welfare and the environment. That report should draw heavily from the Risk Characterization information in Phase II.

#### • Current Status of the Response Actions

Pending approval of the Tier IB Extension

Rationale for continuance of the response actions

Section 40.0730(1) of the MCP outlines the criteria to be considered in the review of a Tier I Permit. A consideration of these criteria with respect to the subject property is as follows:

#### (a) the existence, source, nature and exposure of a disposal site;

A prior developer of the property, Richard Gardiner, had excavated approximately 3000 tons of contaminated soil from both the Hat Factory and the Bailey's Pond parcel under a remediation plan approved by MDEP in 1989. The affected soil was disposed of at the Model Cities Landfill in New York State. However, no post excavation sampling of either property took place to document effectiveness of remedial activities nor were appropriate closure documents filed with MDEP to conclude this matter.

According to the Tier I Transition Classification and Permit Statement issued by MDEP on July 7, 1995, "total mercury contamination in soil was limited to the near surface soil. The higher levels were detected in the top 6" of soil according to a testing program performed by GZA in 1985. The highest level detect on site near Bailey's Pond was 120  $\mu$ g/g wet weight. Contamination had been brought onto the subject site from the mill. No records are available to indicate that the groundwater had ever been testing on site. Testing of groundwater had been performed on the adjacent mil site, and on surface waters on Bailey's Pond itself. No mercury was detected in either case. Tests on fish yielded levels up to .24  $\mu$ g/g (below safety limits established from edible fish of .5  $\mu$ /g). The highest level of mercury detected in pond sediment was 1.71  $\mu$ /g dry weight."

On the behalf of a previously interested purchaser, Simmons Environmental Services, Inc. (SIMMONS) confirmed in 1997 that there are still substantial areas of mercury contaminated soil remaining at the Bailey's Pond parcel. Concentrations of mercury in the upper 1'-2' of soil ranged up to 80 mg/Kg in contrast to the most simplistic risk based concentration limit of 20 mg/Kg for this analyte.

# (b) the nature and extent of danger to health, safety, public welfare and the environment posed by the disposal site:

The site is currently surrounded on two sides by a 6'+ wooden stockade fence in disrepair. The site can be accessed from a perimeter trail around the pond that is frequented by dirt bikes and other motorized vehicles. The subject site appears to be used as shortcut to the trail. There is also access to the site from the north side from the water's edge and the pond itself.

The Division of Wildlife and Fisheries has discontinued stocking the pond. No private wells are at the subject property or its vicinity.

(c) magnitude and complexity of the actions necessary to assess, contain or remove the oil and/or hazardous materials in question;

It appears that all the mercury contaminated soil greater than 10 mg/kg have been removed from the site completely, and material excavated from the site with lesser concentrations was brought to the site for disposal. It was agreed that at least 12" of cover with bituminous pavement over it be placed at the site, and future access be controlled via monitoring and deed restriction.

(d) the extent to where there are legally enforceable standardized methods and criteria available for response actions;

Methods and criteria are established in the MCP and other policy/guidance documents.

(e) the extent to which the Department is persuaded that the applicant has the ability and willingness to perform necessary response actions;

There is a strong willingness by the new PRP to perform required response actions. Funding has been obtained via MassDevelopment.

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) granted a Waste Site Cleanup Tier I Permit to Richard Gardiner, President, MERRIMACK LAND CORPORATION, for comprehensive response actions at this site on July 7, 1995. Pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.0703), an application for a Permit Extension is being submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for this site on November 21, 2002. The application proposes to extend the permit for this site for the following rationale:

 as noted below, the ownership of the disposal site has transferred. The new owner, AMESBURY FOR PARKING LLC, is committed to completing further assessment measures and any remedial response actions that may be required as expeditiously as possible.

Pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.0703), an application for a Permit Transfer is being submitted to the DEP for the above referenced site on November 21, 2002. The application proposes to transfer this permit to C. Daniel Swift, Authorized Member of AMESBURY FOR PARKING LLC.

If this Permit Transfer is approved, C. Daniel Swift, Authorized Member of AMESBURY FOR PARKING LLC will take over comprehensive response actions for the above site. Anyone interested in reviewing the Permit Transfer application should notify DEP by writing to DEP, Bureau of Waste Site Clearup, Northeast Regional Office, 205A Lowell Street, Wilmington, Massachusetts 01887 by December 11, 2002. If anyone notifies DEP of his or her interest in reviewing or submitting comment on the application, DEP will conduct a public comment review period of twenty (20) days that shall run concurrently with DEP's Initial Technical Review of the application. Anyone who fails to notify DEP in writing of his/her interest in commenting on the application by the above date may be deemed to have waived his/her rights, if any, to appeal DEP's permit decision or to intervene in an adjudicatory proceeding with response to this application, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.0770(2).

MGL c.21E and the MCP provide additional opportunities for public notice of and involvement in decisions regarding response actions at disposal sites: (1) the Chief Municipal Official and Board of Health of the community in which the site is located with be notified of major milestones and events, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1403; and (2) upon receipt of a petition from ten or more residents of the municipality in which the disposal site is located, or of a municipality

potentially affected by a disposal site, a plan for involving the public in decisions regarding response actions at the site will be prepared and implemented, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1405.



#### STATEMENT AS TO WHY EXTENSION IS SOUGHT

The conceptual model for this disposal site shows that the most likely release mechanism was atmospheric deposition of dust from buffing operations of dust from buffing operations that involved felt that had been treated with mercury containing salts. That treatment was <u>not</u> done at this disposal site. Instead, the treated felt was shipped to the former Merrimac Hat Factory where it was buffed (to raise the knap) and cut prior to manufacturing felt hats. The buffing discharge was deposited on the Bailey's Pond parcel during northeasterly winds. The surface and subsurface soils have been tested by SIMMONS as well as other investigators since 1985. With the completion of the partial Class A-2 RAO in January 2004, direct exposure to humans and/or environmental receptors with regard to soil has been eliminated.

In February of 2004, SIMMONS personnel cored through the ice cover on Bailey's Pond and collected 12 samples of sediment. Analyses of these sediment samples confirmed that mercuric salt residue is still present. These data were provided to a third party subcontractor that specializes in ecological risk assessments. Following an on site meeting with that subcontractor in March of 2004, a proposal for a detailed ecological risk assessment was received: The estimated cost not including LSP oversight was approximately \$37,000.

Because of construction commitments that were in place at that time it was fiscally impossible for the owner to commit to that expenditure. Since that data, discussions with personnel form the Northeast Regional Office of MassDevelopment Corp. have indicated the potential availability of funding to complete the stage II environmental risk characterization. Moreover, construction activities for the parking area have been completed. Between funding possibility from Mass Development and other sources, the applicant will be able to cover anticipated costs to characterize environmental risk.

The applicant requests that the Department change the proposed date of the submittal of a Phase IV Remedial Implementation Plan form May 29, 2006 to October 31, 2006. The reason for this change is that because of the highly specialized nature of ecological risk characterization, it would be impossible to engage these services and collect and analyzed all of the necessary data given that the pond will not be fully accessible for collection and analysis of all of the required environmental receptors until the spring of 2006. By extending the proposed data until October 31, 2006, this will provide sufficient time to fully characterize the risk and develop a Remedy Implementation Plan.

The applicant does not propose any changes to the May 29, 2007 data for submittal of a Response Action Outcome Statement.



#### COMPLIANCE HISTORY

The permittee has no compliance history with the Department or any federal environmental regulatory agencies. The relevant compliance issue is the Notice of Non Compliance for failure to have submitted a Response Acton Outcome Statement by May 17, 2005.

Since the date of the original transfer, the applicant has reduced risk to human health by completing a Release Abatement Measure (RAM) that involved excavation of soil containing mercury. The original plan indicated that an Activity and Use Limitation would be used to restrict future exposure. However, the property owner subsequently opted to notify the local Conservation Commission and proceed with excavation and off site disposal of affected soil. A partial Class A-2 Response Action Outcome Statement was submitted in January of 2004.
